Contributions for Part III Places of the IL

This part of the document is very important because it refers to the concreteness of synodality in the local churches. Thinking about the numbers in general, I would like to make some contributions:

- Changes generally do not come from the top down but the other way around. Hence, every transformation that takes place at the local level will open the way for the implementation of the synodal. We should not fear change the ecclesial organization, but should be able to recognize the action of the Spirit in these changes.

- It is important to make better use of what already exists of ecclesial organizations and to ask for the integration of more women, young people and the poor. But this is not enough. We must not stifle the creativity of the spirit that can give rise to new organizations that make synodality more real. Remember the biblical quote of “pouring new wine into new wineskins” that invites us to novelty and the possibility of new organisms, more agile and updated to today's world.

- We should not be afraid of leaving some organisms because everything has its time and can change and even needs to change. Why not think of more novelties and stop longing for a past that is no longer meaningful for today's people?
